I. **Approval of Minutes** – January 4, 2024

Motion by Bolton, seconded by Collins, to approve the minutes of the January 4, 2023 meeting. Motion carried.

II. **Finance Reports** –

Kim Murphy reviewed the finance report. A discussion was held to remove the "unused projects" categories going forward.

III. **Sheriff**

2024 goals and objectives are included in the packet. Sherriff stated they have also been working closely with CMH and plan to continue doing so.

The Sheriff provided information about **Smart 911**. Smart911 is a software that interacts with dispatch and emergency personnel. It allows an emergency and medical professionals to be informed of individualized information and medical history of the residents within the home they are responding. The public may register for this service at [Smart911.com](https://www.smart911.com).

Jail pods went live on Monday and thus far, everything is running smoothly.

IV. **Prosecuting Attorney** Jackie Wyse shared that her report is included in the packet, nothing additional to add. Comm Collins asked what the Victim Rights percentage means. Jackie stated they were made aware the new computer system is not reflecting numbers accurately, and they are working on resolving that issue.

V. **Public Defender** John Glaser did not have a report to share. He stated the winter is usually slower and no drastic changes recently. A new Public Defender has started in the office today, as one attorney recently relocated.

- VI. Emergency Management** Craig Tanis stated their newest drone was utilized at a recent vehicle accident. The accident coordinates were programed into the drone to capture video and photographic images of the scene.

Additional information software will be coming that will communicate with the drone to assist in accident investigations. They hope to utilize the drone at Fire Departments in the future.

- VII. Medical Examiner** – Sarah Palmani shared numbers reflected in the report. There are some pending cases and once those are completed, the year-end report will be completed.

Sarah reported that the roster for Medical Investigators is currently low. The current investigators are doing an excellent job and are committed to their county.

Typically, the morgue is at full capacity. This can be due to various reasons but mostly they remain there until the family makes arrangements.

- VIII. Courts** Heidi Cannon shared they've had a new appointment of a District Judge, now Chief Judge Morgan.

Ciara McGrane shared some recent legislative changes, the biggest one being Extreme Risk Protective Orders. They are working to establish a policy that will work for Lenawee County. The courts have scheduled a training on 2/8 with judges and decision makers, to implement and plan for the protocols that will be going in to place.

Ciara reported the Judges are pleased with new jail pods; it is a great benefit to the courts with enhanced audio.

Appellate Attorneys have increased clerical work with the changes to Appellate Billing. In the past, billing was reported at the conclusion of a case. Billing will now be reported on a monthly basis.
