Call to the public – None

Approval of Agenda – A Motion to approve the current agenda was made by Sheriff Bevier and supported by Chief Wilson. The motion passed unanimously.

Minutes from the previous meeting

The minutes from the April 18, 2023, meeting were provided to members ahead of the meeting. The minutes were approved as presented on a motion by Comm. Collins and support from D. Craig.

Financial report- The secretary reviewed the FY20, FY21, and FY22 grant fund balance and the 234 Donation fund balance. The financial report was accepted on a motion by Chief Wilson and support from T. Garcia.

Emergency Manager's report – Written report provided highlights of the Emergency Manager's activities from April 2023 through May 2023. EM Tanis also updated the committee

on the EOC Functional Exercise. The EM report was accepted on a motion by Sheriff Bevier and support from D. Craig.

E-911 updates – Lt. Perdue provided the committee with a written report and gave a verbal update supporting the written report, including staffing updates and adding a 911 controller just for Lenawee County. Lt. Perdue also reported the MIS dispatch project is complete, the mobile backup equipment is in, and they have added a fourth redundancy on the phone system. The E-911 report was accepted on a motion by Chief Wilson and supported by B. Ricker.

Drone Sub-committee – Chief Wilson updated the committee on continued training efforts at the schools. The drone team now has 15 pilots on the roster, and there will be a training scenario in August specific to the large hazmat drone. The Drone Sub-committee report was accepted on a motion by Sheriff Bevier and support from T. Garcia.

Old Business

- Fentanyl Training – Phil Salinas provided fentanyl and other illicit drug training free of charge for Lenawee County first responders on June 13th.
- EM Tanis was able to procure 28 Level III+ plate carriers with front and back plates through a regional grant.

New Business

- Grant Request:
 - FY22 SHSP - \$5,000 for four LE personnel to attend Blu Bearing Solutions Active Shooter Engagement training course. The request was unanimously approved on a motion by Chief Wilson and support from Sheriff Bevier.
- Ed Soto – Alternate for Travis Howell – Tabled until next meeting.
- EM Tanis provide the committee with the following items for informational purposes only, requiring no action:
