I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 by Chairman Cuevas

II. New Business

A. Purchase of 911 Training and Transport vehicle

Lt. Perdue presented the facts and reasoning for requesting the approval to purchase a vehicle for 911 employees. This vehicle would be used for our 911 employees to travel to and from training. Dispatchers are required to attend 24 hours of continuing education training every 24 months. The vehicle will also be used to transport our mobile backup kits and the MAK (mobile anywhere kit). These kits allow us to set up a three-position backup center anywhere there is an internet connection. Dispatch employees have previously been able to use a decommissioned patrol vehicle or DB vehicle. However, these vehicles are becoming hard to come by and are unreliable. This year, we have requested vehicles to send our 911 employees to training and there either hasn't been one available, or one that is available, isn't reliable enough to send the distance they will be traveling. We have had vehicles break down, or they are driving their vehicles and being reimbursed at the county's rate which is currently \$.67 per mile. The Sheriff reiterated that the purchase of a vehicle for 911 training is an allowable expense. The vehicle price is also a state contract price. Discussion took place and additional questions were answered. Mr. Dixon made a motion to recommend the purchase of the proposed vehicle to move forward to the Physical Resources committee, supported by Dispatcher Benner. Motion passed.
