Program coordinator Julie Maurer shared that she had written news releases on low waste camping trips and beach days. She is working on one about back-to-school, including supply recycling at Staples and also shopping at our resale shops in Lenawee County.

Maurer spent time at the county fair this month, talking to people about the program and encouraging them to take the survey. She also attended master composter training sessions conducted by the MSU extension at the River Raisin Watershed Council and will take her exam soon.

She applied for a \$30,000 environmental justice grant to build out the fifth bay at the recycling

drop off site for special recycling collections. She is in the process of applying for an organics infrastructure grant.
