Minutes: Thursday, November 13, 2025

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by Chief Nic Wilson.

II. Approval of Minutes

A. Approval of Minutes: ____

Commissioner Collins made a motion to accept the September meeting minutes, supported by Sheriff Bevier. No discussion, motion carried.

III. Reports - Emergency 911 District Board

A. E911 Finance Report

Lt. Perdue advised that the financial statement was attached. She pointed out that at this point we should be at 85.59% and we are just under at 84%. Revenues are at 60% which is down, this is due to some of the carrier's payments not being received yet. Commissioner Collins asked if some cell carriers are traditionally slow at payment, Lt. Perdue confirmed the statement. Lt. Perdue will be monitoring the payments coming in.

Mr. Tanis made a motion to accept the financial report, seconded by Ms. Benner. No further discussion, motion carried.

B. E911 Director's Report

Lt. Perdue highlighted a few items from the attached Director's report.

The first item being the name of the newly created position. The name started as a System's

Coordinator and after some meetings with County IT and County HR, the name has been changed to System's Specialist. Commissioner Collins asked if it was the same classification, Lt. Perdue advised the only thing that changed was the name.

Second item highlighted was the CAD to CAD project with Hillsdale County. Sgt. Hudson has been working with Hillsdale's Director to work out the issues that have been coming up.

Third item was continuing to educate ourselves of keeping up firmware and upgrades to the radio system. Many meetings have been had and more will continue.

October 7th some of our Vendors came into the Center to help with cleaning of the computer systems. This helps keep the computer running properly.

Staffing levels: 18 fully trained Dispatchers, one in step 3 of training and one to start on November 16th.

IV. Existing Business

A. Law Enforcement Representative vacancy

Chairman Nic Wilson advised that the Police Chief's Association has appointed Chief David Gentner as their representative. Mr. Tanis made a motion to recommend approval to the Rules and Appointments Committee. Supported by Commissioner Collins. No Discussion. Motion carried.
