II. Approval of Agenda

Mr. Tanis made a motion to accept the agenda, supported by Chief Gentner. Motion carried.

III. Election of Chair and Vice Chair

Mr. Tanis made a motion for Chief Wilson to be the chair of this committee, supported by Commissioner Collins. Motion carried.

V. Reports - Emergency 911 District Board

A. E911 Finance Report

Lt. Perdue advised there were two financial reports attached, one for 2025 and one for 2026. The expenditures for 2025 were at 75%, however, 4th quarter payments had started coming in. Expenditures were at 92%.

Lt. Perdue pointed out that the 2026 budget, all line items showed 0%, however, the end report showed 2%. She explained this has to do with the payment coming out for Dispatch's portion of all County services has already been taken out.

B. E911 Director's Report

No update on CAD to CAD with Hillsdale County.

MEVO Anywhere Kit (MAK)- Central Dispatch now has the kit and is available for use.

In Building Coverage in Blissfield has shown some improvement after the firmware upgrade per Chief Greenleaf.

VI. Existing Business

A. Open "general public representative" position

The Board received one application from Mr. Robert Trevino (application attached). Chairman Wilson opened the floor for a motion to accept the application. No Motion was made. Sheriff Bevier expressed a request from a past board member, Doug Lerch, who had expressed his feelings that the citizen at large position to be filled by citizens who has not been in law enforcement, fire, etc. This being his only reservation. Chairman Wilson asked if he still worked in law enforcement, Rob advised he does not. Further discussion was had in reference to how long the posting was online. It was determined that the posting was not online and Mr. Trevino saw the possible opening from a previous meeting. Administrator Murphy did explain that they are not typically posted, that the county does advertise periodically on social media that positions are open. There is also a talk during the Ways and Means committee where the open positions are discussed.
