Minutes: Thursday, March 12, 2026

I. Call to Order

Chairman Wilson called the meeting to order at 15:00.

II. Approval of Minutes

A. Approval of Minutes: ____

Mr. Tanis made a motion to approve the minutes from the packet, supported by Commissioner Collins. Motion carried.

III. Reports - Emergency 911 District Board

A. E911 Finance Report

Lt. Perdue advised that the financial statement was attached. She highlighted that the budget should be at 17.17% and it is currently at 14%. She also pointed out that 4th quarter revenue payments have started coming in and that is at 28%. No further discussion.

B. E911 Director's Report

Lt. Perdue advised that the Director's Report was attached. She highlighted the following items;

- 1. On February 2nd, 2026, Shift Leader Brian Wilcox was promoted to Communications Systems Specialist. SS Wilcox was introduced.*
- 2. CAD to CAD project went live on February 12th, 2026.*
- 3. County Wide Tornado siren test is scheduled for Thursday, March 19th, 2026 at 17:55.*
- 4. Tyler Software upgrade is in progress with the production side being upgraded on April*

15th, 2026. Systems will be down during that day.

5. Staffing, currently at 19 Dispatchers with 1 position open.

Mr. Tanis asked which systems would be down during the upgrade. Lt. Perdue and Sgt. Hudson explained the different systems and platforms.

Travis Bates and Sherri Luce both gave a short introduction and brief history about themselves.

Ms. Benner's motion was back on and supported by Chief Gentner.

No additional recommendations were made.

Motion carried to nominate Travis Bates for the open General Public Representative.

B. Subcommittee to review board by-laws
